2017-2018 CURRICULUM:

Earth Science Interactive Science book and online
Labs will be performed, whenever possible.

GRADING:

Quarterly grades are determined by averaging assessment grades, homework, labs/STEM projects, and classwork. Assessments may be announced or unannounced.

There will be a cumulative final exam in June. Assessments, chapter practice sheets and vocabulary will be in Google Classroom, and chapter guided notes will be found in Google Classroom for reference and studying purposes.

HOMEWORK POLICY:

Students will be assigned both long and short term assignments throughout the year. Homework assignments are corrected or collected at the beginning of each class period. Students who did not complete the previous night's assignment are encouraged to follow along and write down the correct answers, so that they can use the assignment when they study for upcoming assessments. Homework is due on the assigned day with no additional time unless absent. Students should look over guided notes, vocabulary, and handouts every night. Homework assignments are emailed to the student weekly and available on the school website: www.greenville.k12.ny.us.

EXTRA CREDIT:

Extra credit assignments may be available throughout the year. It will be the student's responsibility to get the information and complete the assignment on time. No late extra credit is accepted.

BAND LESSON:

Students must come to class, ask to be excused, write down the homework and classwork assignments for that day, then sign out and return to class during lunch/recess to ask any questions, if necessary. Their classwork and homework must be completed that night and they must be prepared for class the following day.
